1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of award dated 01.09.2025 whereby learned Permanent Lok Adalat (for short 'PLA') has dismissed her claim.

2. The petitioner on 14.11.2022 approached the respondent No.2- dispensary for treatment of her stomach. She was administered medicine. She developed numbness in her left leg. The respondent No.2 assured that her condition will improve over the time. She, on not getting any relief, filed an application under Section 22C of 1987 Act before learned PLA which sought response of the respondent. Matter was tried to be reconciled, however, was finally adjudicated on merits. Learned PLA has concluded that



she did not take treatment from any other hospital, thus, the medical records did not support her claim.

3. None has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner despite two pass-overs.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
