Application seeking for addition of Section 117(2) and 118(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, 2023 has been moved on the ground that inadvertently, in head note and prayer clause, Sections 117(2) and 118(2) of BNS could not be added as the same have been added later on.

In view of abovementioned facts and circumstances, the instant application is hereby allowed and Sections 117(2) and 118(2) of BNS are now added in the head note and prayer clause.

This petition for pre-arrest bail is the first petition filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of 'the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023'. It has been filed with regard to a case arising out of FIR No.12 dated 18.01.2026, for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 333, 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 118(2), 324(4), 351(2), 351(3), 190 and 191(2) of the



Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala.

2. Vide order dated 11.03.2026 the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of arresting officer. It was also directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with order dated 11.03.2026 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. The learned State Counsel has failed status report and on the instructions of ASI Gurmail Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, and that for further investigation of this case his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions and the fact that the petitioner has already joined the investigation, it is hereby ordered that the petitioner is entitled for anticipatory bail. Hence, the present petition is hereby ***allowed*** and the order dated 11.03.2026, whereby the petitioner was accorded the benefit of interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute.
