Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing respondents No.1 to 6 to get the detenue, namely, Gurpreet Kaur from the illegal detention of private respondent No.7.

2. Pursuant to the order of preceding date, respondent No.7 Sunil Kumar as also alleged detenue-Gurpreet Kaur have been produced in Court.

3. This Court has interacted with the alleged detenue-Gurpreet Kaur with the able assistance of learned State counsel.
