1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 30.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Writ Court in CWP-21549-2025, titled as 'Pritpal Kaur vs. State Transport Commissioner and another' whereby it was directed that "legal notice dated 26.05.2025 submitted by the petitioners be decided by the respondents by passing an appropriate order withing a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order".

2. Learned counsel for the respondent has filed compliance report dated 20.03.2026 by way of affidavit of Baljinder Singh Dhillon, PCS, Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Jalandhar, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the respondent has pointed out that in compliance of the Writ Court order, the legal notice dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioners stands duly decided by the



respondent vide Speaking Order dated 16.03.2026 (Annexure R-1/1). As such, nothing survives in the present petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the compliance effected, no further directions are required to be passed and the present petition be disposed of.

4. Ordered accordingly.

6. The petitioners would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order, in accordance with law, if so advised or any cause of action still survives.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
