NIDHI GUPTA J. (Oral)

Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 28.7.2025 (Annexure P-6) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-8661-2016 titled as “Sukhdev Singh and others vs. Haryana Power Generation Corporation Ltd. and others”, whereby the petition was disposed of as not pressed on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents to the effect that “*...in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioners, the same will be considered and appropriate order on the said representation/claim will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of any such claim and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be*



mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.....”.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that necessary compliance has been made while passing a Speaking Order dated 27.4.2026; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid Speaking order dated 27.4.2026 produced by the learned counsel for the respondents is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the Writ Court order dated 28.7.2025 (Annexure P-6) has been complied with while passing a Speaking Order dated 27.4.2026 by respondent No.3/competent authority, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same may be disposed of.

In view of the above noted facts and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present contempt petition is **disposed of.**

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
