NIDHI GUPTA J. (Oral)

Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 13.10.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-29256-2025 titled as “Suman Rani vs. State of Haryana and others”, whereby the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents to the effect that “.....*the petitioner’s due salary from February to June 2025, will be released within a period of four weeks. Her case for readjustment in some other School will also be considered, and the decision taken thereupon will be conveyed to her within eight weeks therefrom.....*”.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State has handed over a copy of the Pay Order dated 21.10.2025 and submits that the EPS Amount of Rs.1,22,465/- has been released in favour of



the petitioner and therefore, submits that since the compliance of the Writ Court order has been made; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the said Pay Order is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that since the compliance of the Writ Court order has been made, the present contempt petition may be disposed of.

Heard.

In view of the facts noted above and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition stands **disposed of**.

Rule stands discharged.
