1. The present matter pertains to the year 2002 and has remained pending for a considerable period. On 09.07.2025, when the matter was taken up for hearing, notice to the appellants was directed to be issued and the case was accordingly adjourned to 22.07.2025. On the said date, none appeared on behalf of either party, despite due intimation having been conveyed through electronic mail. It was also recorded that there appeared to be no possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties. Even today, when the matter has been called on for hearing, there is no appearance on behalf of the appellants. The position thus remains unchanged. In view of the repeated non-appearance of the parties, it can reasonably be inferred that they are no longer interested in prosecuting the present appeal. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal pending on the docket indefinitely.

2. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution.

3. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands disposed of, all pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them pending.
