JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to refund 10% security money and EMD payment with respect to work carried out by him for the respondent along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 & 3, on instructions from Mr. Sanjeev Gupta, Executive Engineer, M.C. Faridabad, submits that admitted liability would be discharged within three months from today.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent may be subjected to interest @ 6% per annum from the date of passing bills.



4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to release payment to the petitioner within three months from today along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of passing bills. It is made clear that if payment is not released within aforesaid period, the rate of interest would be 9% from the expiry of said period.

5. Pending Misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
