HARSH BUNGER J. (Oral)

1. Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for setting aside the order dated 18.12.2025 (Annexure P-10) passed by learned Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak, whereby he has set aside the partition proceedings and remanded the matter to learned Assistant Collector for deciding the matter afresh after inspecting the spot in presence of both the parties and then prepare fresh Naksha Bey.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would not press the instant petition as far as the challenge to the order dated 18.12.2025 (Annexure P-10) is concerned; however, since the partition proceedings have been pending for the last more than 8 years; accordingly he submits that time bound direction be issued to learned Assistant Collector for deciding the remanded matter.

3. Notice of motion to State for the aforesaid limited extent only.

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4. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State and submits that the learned Assistant Collector shall make an earnest endeavor to conclude the partition proceedings in pursuance to the remand order dated 18.12.2025 (Annexure P-10) passed by learned Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak, within a period of six months from today.

5. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however considering the fact that the partition proceedings in this matter have been pending since the year 2018, accordingly, I deem it appropriate to direct learned Assistant Collector concerned to conclude the partition proceedings expeditiously and preferably within six months from today (subject to any legal impediment or order passed by higher authority/court) in accordance with law.

6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
