SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ particularly in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 27.07.2015 (P-2) vide which the benefit of 3rd ACP granted to petitioner was withdrawn and consequently his pay was reduced, illegally, arbitrarily and against the settled principles of law.

2. Submissions by way of an affidavit of Dr. Raja Sekhar Vundru, Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Transport Department, Chandigarh has been filed and the same is taken on record. A copy of the same stands furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.



3. Learned State counsel has drawn attention to this Court to para 6 of the said affidavit, which reads as under:-

“That in order to comply with the order dated 07.04.2026 passed by this Hon'ble Court the cost of Rs. 1,00,000/- is deposited to the Nishkam Sewa High Court Lawyers' Society, Chandigarh, A/c No.: 43373609961 IFSC: SBIN0050306 Bank: State Bank of India, High Court Branch, Chandigarh from the object Head "3055-Road Transport-001-Direction and Administration. The copy of Bankers Cheque No. 350256" 000002000: 000575" 16 amounting to Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) is annexed herewith as Annexure R-2 and copy of deposit slip of the same is annexed herewith as Annexure R-3.”

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the necessary relief in the instant petition stands addressed, to which learned State counsel, on instructions from Rahul Jain, GM, Transport, Jind, and Ashwani Dogra, GM, Ambala, has assured the Court that the same shall be released within a period of four weeks from today.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not controvert the aforesaid averments made by learned State counsel and very fairly accepts the claim of the petitioner, to which he is entitled from the year 2014 qua the 3rd ACP. The arrears accruing to the petitioner shall also carry interest.

6. Mr. Rahul Dev Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana, informs the Court that he has fairly spoken to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Transport Department, Chandigarh, regarding the grant of interest, and the same is under active consideration. He further submits that the same shall also be considered and released to the petitioner along with the arrears within a period of four weeks.



7. In the light of above, nothing survives in the instant petition.
8. Accordingly, same is disposed off, having been rendered infructuous.
