1. Petitioner filed this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for seeking transfer of civil suit bearing Civil Suit No.CS-1555-2020 titled as Shingara Singh Pannu versus Inderjit Singh from Civil Court at Gurdaspur to some Civil Court at Batala and with regard to that a petition was filed by the petitioner. Vide impugned order dated 19.02.2026 learned District Judge, Gurdaspur ordered transfer of Civil Suit from one Civil Court at Gurdaspur to another Civil Court at Gurdaspur whereas it has been clearly stated in the application that he has no grievance against any Judicial Officer posted at Gurdaspur rather he is facing difficulty in getting legal assistance as respondent is a Senior Advocate at Gurdaspur and no Bar Member is willing to come forward to assist the petitioner.

2. Perusal of the impugned order clearly shows that the learned District Judge has not correctly appreciated the contents of the application filed by the petitioner as petitioner has specifically made a request for transfer of his case from Civil Courts at Gurdaspur to any Civil Court at Batala and respondent/defendant has made a statement that he has no objection in case Civil Suit is transferred. In such circumstances, it appears that the learned District



Judge has not exercised the jurisdiction vested in him properly and has misread the contents of the application filed by the petitioner, as such, the instant revision petition is allowed and impugned order is set aside. The matter is remanded to the learned District Judge, Gurdaspur for deciding afresh as per the application filed by the petitioner.

3. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands disposed of, all miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them.
