VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the appellant submitted that he is not in touch with the appellant. Notice was ordered to be issued to the appellant. Notice issued to the sole appellant has been received back with the report that he has died. None has come present to implead the LRs of the appellant. In the absence of LRs of appellant, case cannot proceed further.

2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the case on the docket, indefinitely.
