SUBHAS MEHLA, J (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS for issuance of direction to respondent authorities to not conduct multiple enquiries and also not to summon repeatedly petitioner for fresh enquiries, on the frivolous complaints moved by respondent no.5 and to restrain the respondent no.3 from initiating or conducting multiple enquiries on identical allegations.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on frivolous complaints moved by respondent no.5 enquiries are being conducted against the petitioner and he is being repeatedly summoned for fresh enquiries, therefore, respondent no.3 be restrained from initiating or conducting multiple enquiries on identical allegations.

3. In pursuance of advance notice Mr.Anup Singh, AAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondent/State and apprised the Court, on instructions from DSP Head Quarter Satwant Singh, that the petitioner withdrew the first enquiry on the ground that he does not want any investigation; regarding second enquiry, the complaint moved by the complainant / respondent no.5



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has been consigned/filed as the enquiry has already been decided on 02.04.2026 in favour of the petitioner; and third one has been disposed of by observing that matter has already been enquired into.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition may be disposed of in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent/State.

5. Heard.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. Present petition is disposed of in view of the statement of the learned State counsel.
