The instant contempt petition alleges disobedience of order dated 04.12.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-21202-2025;

“5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same as per law/rules within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

2. Learned counsel representing the State of Punjab submits that in compliance of the directions issued vide order dated 04.12.2025 (ibid), speaking order dated 20.04.2026 has been passed and the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present contempt petition and that the petitioner shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law against the said order.



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4. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of as not having been pressed.
