This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the Common Eligibility Test (CET-2025) result dated 04.12.2025 (Annexure P-1) and all related records, to the extent the petitioner has been considered under the General Category instead of BC-A Category. He further prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to correct and update the category of the petitioner from General Category to BC-A Category in the CET-2025 (Group-C) official records and digital portal in accordance with Advertisement No. 01/2025.



On 16.03.2025, learned counsel for the petitioner was directed to place on record the evidence/any proof of receipt of the application submitted to the authorities for issuance of BC-A category certificate prior to the cut-off date for submission of applications pursuant to Advertisement No. 01/2025 dated 26.05.2025 and the case was adjourned to 25.03.2026.

On 25.03.2026, the case was adjourned to 20.04.2026 on the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Today, neither anyone has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner nor any receipt has been placed on record so far after a lapse of more than one month by now and three dates have been consumed for the said purpose.

In light of the above, this Court is duly convinced that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition seriously.

Hence, the petition is ordered to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
