SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 02.02.2026 passed by this Court in CRM-M-2370-2026, whereby direction was issued to the respondent to decide the representation dated 02.12.2025 filed by the petitioner.

2. In compliance of the order dated 02.02.2026 passed by this Court in CRM-M-2370-2026, learned counsel for the respondent has produced a compliance affidavit dated 19.04.2026 of Sartaj Singh Chahal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur, along with Annexures R-1 to R-3), on behalf of the respondent in the Court. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the
