NEERJA K. KALSON, J.

1. The Petitioner has approached this Court by filing instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (corresponding Section 438 Cr.P.C.) for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.002 dated 07.01.2026 (Annexure P-3) registered under Section 117(2), 115(2), 126(2), 85, 191(3), 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) (corresponding Section 325, 323, 341, 498-A, 148, 149 IPC) at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural.

2. This Court vide order dated 19.03.2026, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to her joining the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 19.03.2026, the petitioner has joined the investigation.



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4. Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits that as per instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh, Police Station Bhindi Saidon, District Amritsar Rural, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

5. In view of the above, the order dated 19.03.2026 is made absolute.

6. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
