1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No.36 dated 29.01.2026, under Sections 316(2), 85 of BNS, Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali). This is the first petition for anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 17.03.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer-SI Sukhwinder Singh submits that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for any further investigation.



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4. Mr. Gopal Singh Nahel, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his Vakalatnama in Court today, which is taken on record.

5. Heard.

6. Petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to order of this Court dated 17.03.2026. In the circumstances of the case but without commenting on merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.03.2026, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.

7. Learned counsels for the parties submit that the parties are willing for mediation. The parties may apply to the jurisdictional Magistrate who would then refer the matter for meditation before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of District SAS Nagar, Mohali.
