VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of the order dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M-31784 of 2024, directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib to decide the representation submit by the petitioner in accordance with law.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid directions, the representation was decided vide order dated 03.08.2024. A copy of the said order has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present contempt petition as no grievance subsists and the petitioner shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law, in case the petitioner is aggrieved by the said order.



4. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of as not having been pressed.
