1. This is a petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking directions to the respondent police authorities not to harass the petitioners by repeatedly calling them in connection with the same complaint, which has already been subjected to earlier three inquiries and filed on the ground that the dispute is purely civil in nature.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the police is again harassing the petitioners by calling them in the same complaint, which has already been subjected to three inquiries and has already been filed.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. H.S.Wadhwa, DAG Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submitted that the complaint in question has already been filed after conducting inquiries and there is nothing on



record to show that the police is again calling the petitioners. It is further submitted that there is no requirement of the petitioners in the said complaint as the inquiries have already been concluded.

5. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned State counsel that the petitioners are not being called to the police station after the conclusion of the inquiries and filing of the complaint, the present petition stands disposed of having become infructuous.
