Seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the petitioner for 08 weeks parole to enable him to meet and look after his family members and to settle household affairs, the petitioner who has been convicted in the FIR captioned above, has come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India r/w 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act 1962.

2. Perusal of the file shows petitioner has filed an appeal against conviction before this Court bearing number CRA-D-1174-2025, which has been admitted on 09.09.2025. However, perusal of the petition does not refer to any denial of parole by any authority. In such circumstances, there is no lis at this stage and this Court is not inclined to allow the petition. However, before dismissing the petition, we clarify that if the petitioner files an application for



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parole before the concerned authorities, the same shall be decided within three weeks positively and in case, parole is rejected, the reasoned order must be passed and the same be communicated to the representationist as well as his counsel without delay and through e-mail, which the petitioner's counsel would mention in the application for parole, if filed.

3. Petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observations. Liberty reserved to approach this Court, if need arises. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
