JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents No. 2 & 3 to initiate disciplinary and departmental proceedings against respondents No. 4 to 6 for illegally entering into their premises.

2. The respondents No. 4 to 6 are posted in CIA, Sirhind, Police Station Sirhind and Police Station, Fatehgarh Sahib respectively. The petitioners claim that respondents in connivance with private individuals, without warrant or probable cause, entered their premises. The petitioners are not facing any criminal case still respondents have entered their premises. They have filed representations dated 03.11.2025 and 16.10.2025 against



respondents No.4 to 6 seeking initiation of disciplinary and departmental proceedings.

3. Learned State counsel submits that petitioners are not innocent ones. The petitioner No.1 is involved in NDPS cases. They have approached Human Rights Commission besides filing civil suit for the same prayer as made in the present case.

4. The petitioners are projecting themselves as if they are innocent persons and Police is attempting to implicate them in one or another case. They have approached Human Rights Commission besides Civil Court, thus, there seems no reason or justification to direct higher Police Authorities to initiate proceedings against respondents No. 4 to 6. The petitioners are at liberty to pursue remedies as permissible by law.

5. In the backdrop, the petition stands dismissed.

6. Pending Misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
