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**RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0011 dated 27.01.2026, registered under Sections 281, 125(a), 324(4), 115(2), 304(2), 132, 221, 191(3) of the BNS, 2023, at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.

2. On 08.04.2026, the following order was passed by this Court: -

*"Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0011 dated 27.01.2026, registered under Sections 281, 125(a), 324(4), 115(2), 304(2), 132, 221, 191(3) of the BNS, 2023, at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.*



*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further contends that the petitioner has no concern with the said offence and the allegations levelled against him are vague. Learned counsel contends that the alleged injury attributed to the petitioner is on the non-vital part of the body of complainant and the same is simple in nature. It has been contended that co-accused Ravi Inder Singh alias Raviinder Singh, Nihal Singh alias Sukhdeep Singh and Rajdeep Singh alias Deepa have already been granted the concession of interim bail by this Court vide order dated 09.03.2026, passed in CRM-M-10206-2026. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner has clean antecedents as he is not involved in any other case and he is ready and willing to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the investigating agency. Therefore, it is urged that the instant petition be allowed.*

*Notice of motion.*

*At the asking of the Court, Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He seeks time to file reply/status report.*

*Ms. Yagsimant Attri, Advocate has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. The same is taken on record. She, while opposing the petition for anticipatory bail, has contended that the petitioner has played an active role in the crime and, thus, does not deserve the concession of bail.*

*Adjourned to 23.04.2026.*

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within a week from today and would appear as and when required by the Investigating Officer and cooperate with the Investigating Agency. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.”*

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.04.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions of ASI Gurdarshan Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the complainant submits that the offence committed by petitioner is serious in nature and hence, opposes the grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 08.04.2026 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
