1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to count the services rendered by the petitioners as Special Police Officer as qualifying service for the purpose of retiral benefits.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-9936-2017** titled as "**Sukhjeet Singh and others Vs. The State of Punjab and others**", decided on 15.02.2018. Learned counsel on instructions from the petitioners, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 18.01.2026 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.
