KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner-senior citizen has approached this Court, by filing the instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, assailing the order dated 13.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), vide which, the order dated 19.07.2022 (Annexure P-9), thereby, allowing the application preferred by her, under Section 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, was set aside. However, the respondent-son was directed to pay an amount of Rs.6,000/- to the petitioner.

2. Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, confines the prayer only to the extent that the amount of maintenance be adequately enhanced.

3. In response, learned counsel for respondent No.4, submits that the respondent-son, in order to give quietus to the dispute, is ready to pay an amount of Rs.8,000/- per month to his mother-petitioner towards maintenance till her lifetime.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner-senior citizen has graciously accepted the offer.

5. In view of the abovesaid consensus arrived at between the parties, this Court is not required to delve into the merits of the case. Accordingly, the impugned order is modified to the extent that respondent No.4 shall remit an amount of Rs.8,000/-, as maintenance, by 10th day of every month in the bank account of the petitioner, till her lifetime. In the event of default in payment of maintenance amount, the senior citizen shall be at liberty to move an apt application for revival of the instant writ petition.

6. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**, in the above terms.
