1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner(s) for directions to the respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioner(s) has filed the representation dated 07.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) before the respondent No.2. The learned counsel prays for disposing of the present petition by issuing directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representation within a stipulated time.

3. **Notice of motion** to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.



4. Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Hence service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is hereby directed that by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this order, the representation of petitioner(s) (Annexure P-1) be disposed of either by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No.2) or, on assignment by him, by any other police officer not below the rank of Deputy Commissioner of Police. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representation. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representation of the petitioner and take an independent decision at his own level.

6. In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
