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1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the areas of salary, consequential benefits arising out of the retrospective promotion as Assistant w.e.f. 15.12.2008 and as a Deputy Suptt. W.e.f. 26.10.2018 and other consequential monetary benefits in view of letter dated 16.04.2025 (P-20) and 16.07.2025 (P-21) as well as the judgment passed by this Court in ***CWP-2946-2019 titled Chander Bhan Vs. State of Haryana & Anr.*** decided on 20.02.2026 (Annexure P-24).

2. Notice of motion.

3. Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, DAG Haryana, having been served with an advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures this Court that the representation dated 10.03.2026 (Annexure P-23) shall be decided, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.



4. In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Financial Commissioner-cum-Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Sector 17, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the representation dated 10.03.2026 (Annexure P-23), in view of judgment passed by this Court in **CWP-2946-2019 titled Chander Bhan Vs. State of Haryana & Anr.** decided on 20.02.2026 (Annexure P-24) after providing due opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The order so passed shall be furnished to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
