The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of impugned notice dated 21.09.2020 whereby respondent has raised demand of electricity charges of Rs.2,20,947/- and compounding notice whereby respondent has proposed compounding fee of Rs.24,000/-.
2. The petitioner has paid the compounding fee as well as the demand on 09.11.2020.
