1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to permit her to operate her husband's as well as mother-in-law's bank accounts maintained with State Bank of India & Punjab and Sind Bank.

2. The petitioner claims that her husband has passed away. She is a Non-Resident Indian. She is primarily residing in U.S.A. She is authorized to operate bank account of her husband. She is also authorized to operate bank account of her mother-in-law, however, aforesaid banks are not permitting her to operate bank accounts as well as locker. She has made representation to Ombudsman, Reserve Bank of India but to no avail.

3. In view of limited prayer, this Court without seeking response of respondents finds it appropriate to direct Ombudsman, Reserve Bank of India to look into the matter and pass an appropriate order on petitioner's representation (Annexure P-7) within two weeks



from today.

5. The Registry is directed to send copy of this Court to Ombudsman, Reserve Bank of India.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
