1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to comply with directions dated 13.11.2025 to provide police help for execution of warrant of possession.

2. The petitioner filed application for partition before learned Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Bhadaur. The said application was decided in his favour. Respondent No. 7 unsuccessfully challenged the same before learned Financial Commissioner and this Court. The petitioner approached revenue authorities vide letter dated 23.10.2025 seeking issuance of warrant of possession and sought police help pursuant to which warrant was granted. The revenue authorities requested SSP, Barnala to provide police help for execution of warrant of possession who vide letter dated 13.11.2025 directed SHO, Bhadaur-respondent no. 6 to provide police help in execution of warrant of possession. The petitioner preferred letter dated 06.01.2026 before



respondent No. 3 on account of inaction on the part of respondent No. 6^{2026:PHHC:046626}
but to no avail.

3. Learned State counsel submits that Competent Authority
would do the needful within one month from today.

4. Learned counsel representing the petitioner agrees with the
aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands
disposed of.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
