1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution, against the respondent for willful disobedience of the directions issued by the Writ Court in CWP-30923-2025 vide order dated 16.10.2025 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent, upon instructions from the respondent, informs that personal hearing to the petitioner has been granted and the speaking order will be passed within a period of 04 weeks from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking given on behalf of the respondent, nothing survives in present petition at this stage and the same is disposed of as such. However, in case the aforesaid undertaking is not adhered to within 04 weeks from today, the petitioner shall have liberty to move an appropriate application seeking revival of present petition. In that eventuality, the respondent shall be



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liable to pay costs of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only), to the petitioner.
