JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to ensure that the post-mortem of body of Gagandeep Singh Randhawa be conducted by duly constituted Medical Board outside the State of Punjab preferably at P.G.I.M.E.R., Chandigarh.

2. The petitioner is mother of Gagandeep Singh Randhawa who died in mysterious circumstances. The petitioner is claiming that there was foul play on the part of official respondents. Medical examination of the post-mortem of the dead body be conducted outside the State of Punjab.



3. Learned State counsel submits that Smt. Upender Kaur-wife of the deceased requested authorities to conduct post-mortem of the dead body at Amritsar under videography. The post-mortem is in progress and would be completed during the course of the day. The entire proceedings have been duly videographed. It would be preserved as electronic evidence.

4. Learned counsel representing the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert that his grievance stands redressed.
