The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner anticipating apprehension to her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.8 and 9.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner herein has re-married.

The matter pertains to the year 2023 and there is no document forthcoming on the basis whereof it may be assumed that any threat still subsists.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6-Station House Officer, Police Station City-I Abohar, District Fazilka to look into the grievances of the petitioner as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation dated 18.10.2022 (Annexure P-16) and take appropriate action for protection of her life and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances.



The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above-said representation to respondent No.6-Station House Officer, Police Station City-I Abohar, District Fazilka for requisite compliance.
