RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (ORAL)

This is 3rd petition filed under Section 483 read with Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for interim regular bail to the petitioner for a period of three weeks in view of marriage of his sister which is scheduled for 19.04.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that his sister's marriage is fixed for 19.04.2026 and the marriage related functions will commence from 14.04.2026. He prays that interim bail for three weeks be granted to the petitioner in view of the peculiar facts of the present case.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer of the petitioner on the ground that in the present case heavy quantity of contraband has been recovered which falls under commercial quantity. Hence, he prays that the

present petition be dismissed. However, he has not disputed the factum of marriage of the sister of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present petition and taking a lenient and humanitarian view, this Court deems it fit to grant relief to the petitioner for one day only that too in police custody.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner shall be taken at Village Purana Baare Ke, District Ferozepur (in police custody) and it shall be ensured that the petitioner reaches the said venue by 08.00 A.M. on 19.04.2026. The petitioner shall remain in continuous police custody during the entire period.

It is further directed that the petitioner shall be brought back to the Central Jail, Ferozepur by 05.00 P.M. on the same day. The concerned police officials shall ensure that the petitioner does not escape from custody. The expenses to and fro shall be borne by the petitioner. The petitioner is further directed to fully co-operate with the police.

Copy of this order be sent to the Jail Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur through e-mail.

The present petition stands disposed of.
