1. The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and also directing respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the life of present petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have already filed a representation dated 05.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, however no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sahil Chowdhary, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.



5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to decide the representation dated 05.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioners, qua threat perception in accordance with law within a period of one month from today and grant immediate protection, if any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, is perceived.

6. It is being clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners for legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

7. Pending application(s), if any, is/are disposed of.
