1. Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of proceedings under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondent for alleged willful disobedience of the directions issued by the Writ Court vide order dated 08.09.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed in CRM-M-48287-2025, whereby direction was issued to the respondent to pass a speaking order and to decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of order.

2. On 16.04.2026 following order was passed:

1. *Learned counsel for the respondent informs that the order dated 08.09.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed in CRM-M-48287-2025, stands complied with as an order dated 13.10.2025 has been passed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa. Copy of the said order has been submitted in the Court today, which is taken on record. A copy thereof has also been supplied to the counsel opposite.*

2. *It is further informed that in the FIR No.106 dated 03.06.2025, registered at Police Station City Budhlada, District*



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Mansa, two accused have been arrested and efforts are being made to arrest the remaining accused.

3. Status report by way of affidavit of Bhagirath Singh Meena, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

4. Mr. Balwinder Singh, AAG, Punjab representing the respondent submits that aforesaid order dated 08.09.2025 has already been complied with. There are five accused persons in FIR No. 106 dated 03.06.2025, out of which four have been arrested and proceedings to declare one of the accused as proclaimed offender have already been initiated.

5. No further action is required to be taken in the present petition; as such the present petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
