Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent No.4-District Development and Panchayats Officer, Rupnagar, to complete the proceedings against respondent No.7 (Mamta Devi), Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat Rampur Thoda, Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar, in a time bound manner.

2. Today, Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appears and informs the Court that respondent No.4-District Development and Panchayat Officer, Rupnagar, had marked the enquiry into the allegations against respondent No.7 to the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Nurgur Bedi. He further submits that the proceedings already initiated would be taken to its logical end, within a period of three months from today, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed in the present writ petition
