The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of the order dated 12.12.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed in CWP-37210-2025, vide which the following directions were issued:-

“6. Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice dated 07.10.2025 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereon shall be conveyed to the petitioners. Needless to say, if the petitioner is found entitled to the relief sought, the same shall be granted to him within a period of 01 month thereafter.”

2. Today, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid directions, a speaking order has been passed by the concerned authority on 18.03.2026, as per which, the claim of the petitioner has been kept pending on account of the pendency of a charge-sheet against him. A copy thereof has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.



3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not wish to press the instant contempt petition and shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law against the said speaking order.

4. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of in terms thereof.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
