RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.0249/2025 dated 08.09.2025, under Section 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station DLF Ph-3rd, Gurugram along with subsequent proceedings. Further prayer has been made that further proceedings pending arising out of the present FIR may kindly be stayed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely and frivolously implicated in this case. He submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the agreement arrived at, had executed even a sale deed. He has submitted that all the terms and conditions of the property were disclosed as is evident from the affidavit filed by the complainant. He has submitted that after two years of registration of the sale deed, FIR had been lodged in a clandestine manner. He has contended that the dispute even otherwise is purely of a civil nature and the FIR itself, is not maintainable. However, he has



fairly submitted that the case is under investigation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. He has submitted that the case is under investigation.

5. Heard. As the FIR is under investigation, this Court would refrain from going into the merits of the case presently. However, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach this Court again in case any cause of action accrues after completion of the investigation. The investigating agencies are directed to complete the investigation within a period of one month keeping in view all the attending facts and circumstances of the case and the arguments raised by counsel for the petitioners before this Court as contained in the FIR.
