The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to reimburse the medical expenses incurred by the petitioner on her treatment, as per the applicable Rules.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the Department vide memo dated 24.04.2026, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. Referring to the same, he submits that the petitioner has taken treatment from an unapproved private hospital and her case is being processed by the Department, which includes verification of emergency certificate issued by the concerned Chief Medical Officer and obtaining approval/relaxation of the Administrative Secretary for making payment as per the Rules.



3. In view of the statement, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2/Director, Elementary Education, to finally decide the petitioner's claim for medical reimbursement and make payment of the dues found admissible, within a period of three months.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. In case the claim is not decided and the admissible dues are not released within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
