The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of the directions issued vide orders dated 28.08.2025 and 16.01.2026 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) passed in CWP-25154-2025.

2. The grievance of the petitioner was the rejection of the family pension claim of the petitioner.

3. The writ petition was disposed of on a statement having been given by learned State counsel that the requisite order would be passed in accordance with law within a period of two weeks.

4. Today, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has produced a copy of order dated 22.04.2026 as per which, the sanction has been granted as regards family pension to the petitioner as a special case and on a personal measure. It has also been stated in the said order that upon approval of the same, the matter is being forwarded to the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Haryana for release of the FPPO.



5. Short reply filed by Sh. Naveet Gupta, Principal Accountant General, on behalf of respondent No.3, also filed in the Court today is taken on record.

6. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that upon receipt of the complete case, the needful shall be done within a period of three weeks.

7. In view of the order dated 22.04.2026, no further orders are required to be passed at this stage and the contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
