1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 24.02.2026 passed by this Court in CWP-PIL-35-2026, whereby respondent was directed to decide the representation dated 24.10.2025 submitted by the petitioner.

2. In compliance of the order dated 24.02.2026 passed by this Court in CWP-PIL-35-2026, learned counsel for the respondent has produced a compliance affidavit dated 13.05.2026 of Natha Singh, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Faridkot, along with speaking order dated 07.05.2026 (Annexure R-1), on behalf of the respondent in the Court. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been given to learned



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senior counsel for the petitioner.

3. A perusal of the said compliance affidavit shows that order dated 24.02.2026 passed by this Court in CWP-PIL-35-2026 has been complied with.
