1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the impugned speaking order (Annexure P-4) which is illegal, unlawful and against the principle of natural justice. Further praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to refix the pension as the regular employee of the department and not on the basis of the daily wages employees and to their pay/pension may be refixed on the basis of the considering the regular employee accordingly.
