This is an application under Section 397 Cr.P.C. for suspension of sentence of the applicant-petitioner during the pendency of the revision-petition.

Argues that the applicant-petitioner has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year for commission of offence under Section 420 IPC and that the applicant-petitioner has already undergone about 2½ months of sentence out of total awarded.

Learned counsel for the State has not disputed these facts.

The revision-petition is not likely to be heard in near future. Applicant-petitioner has already undergone about 2½ months



of rigorous imprisonment out of total one year rigorous imprisonment awarded. Hence, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the application of the applicant-petitioner is accepted and the remaining sentence of the applicant-petitioner is suspended during the pendency of the revision-petition.
