Present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner laying challenge to the order dated 13.10.2022 (Annexure P/6) passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur (in the Civil Appeal (i.e. CMA-40-2022); whereby the application filed by the petitioner for staying implementation of the judgment and decree dated 30.04.2013 (Annexure P/2) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Batala, has been dismissed.
