1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the official respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar Rural to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6. It is also prayed for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound expeditious manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has preferred a representation/complaint dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, to look into the

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representation/complaint dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and carefully perused the material available on record.
6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, to consider and decide the representation/complaint dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
