1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0011 dated 07.03.2025, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, IPC {corresponding Sections 318(4), 336(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 61(2) of BNS, 2023} registered at Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.04.2026, passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
