1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Haryana State Agriculture Marketing Board through its Chief Administrator to take a decision on the representation dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-14), submitted on behalf of the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 who appear on advance notice, have no objection if the above prayer is accepted.

3. Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-14),



submitted on behalf of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner/its authorized representative through a reasoned order, preferably within 01 week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.

5. It is further directed that in case, the afore decision is adverse to the petitioner's interest, the same shall be kept in abeyance for a period of 07 days.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
