The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction, especially for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the Application dated 01.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner for rejoining on the post resigned from i.e. Storeman, in a time bound manner, considering the hardships of the family of the petitioner, in peculiar facts and circumstances of the case; in the interest of complete and substantial justice, equity and fair play.
