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**Sumeet Goel, J. (Oral):**

1. The substantive prayer made in the instant petition reads thus:

*“It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the instant petition may kindly be allowed and the petitioner be allowed the concession of interim regular bail for a period of 11 days i.e. from 07.04.2026 to 17.04.2026, in case arising out of the F.I.R No. 96 dated 25.03.2025 registered at Police Station Sadar Nuh u/s 20b (ii) (C) and 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985, i.e. Annexure P-1, to enable the Petitioner to complete the ceremonies in lieu of the unfortunate demise of the father of the Petitioner, namely Late Sh. Devi Ram, on 03.04.2026 in view of the grounds mentioned in the Petition and in the interest of justice and equity.”*

2. Upon notice of the petition having been issued, learned State counsel (on instructions from ASI Jamshed Khan) has submitted that the police has verified the aspect of the father of the petitioner having been passed away and his *Kirya*/last ceremonies being fixed for 14.04.2026. It is also not in dispute that the petitioner is the son of the deceased-Devi Ram.



3. Keeping in view the factual milieu of the case in hand, especially the factum of the petitioner being the elder son of the deceased required to perform certain last rites, the petitioner is afforded the concession of interim regular bail for a period of 6 days commencing from tomorrow i.e. 11.04.2026, subject to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall be required to appear before the concerned Court/CJM on 17.04.2026 latest by 11:00 AM. It is made clear that, in case, the petitioner does not surrender back, the concerned Court, which has released the petitioner on interim regular bail, shall take requisite steps to take him back into the custody.

4. Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
